Checklist for Annotated Bibliography

- Did you remember to double-space everything? No extra space between annotations.
- Do not number the annotations.
- Do you have enough annotations?
- In annotation, did you include a summary of the source?
- In annotation, did you include a reflection of how the source is helpful or used in your paper?
- Check for length. Annotations should be one paragraph long (4-6 sentences).
- Are your sources Alphabetized?
- Is your name on the paper?
- Are your annotations tabbed once under your citations?
- Do you have proper MLA citations?
