POLICY: Vanguard ADD – Safe Schools

POLICY ADOPTED: 11-15-16

The Board recognizes that effective learning and teaching takes place in a safe, secure, and welcoming environment and that safe schools contribute to improved attendance, increased student achievement, and community support. To that end, the Board directs the Executive Director, through the Principals, to develop a safe schools plan that includes:

1. Procedures that address the supervision and security of school buildings and grounds.
2. Procedures that address the supervision of students during school hours and school-sponsored activities.
3. Procedures that address persons visiting school buildings and attending school-sponsored activities.
4. Procedures for safe, confidential reporting of security and safety concerns at each building.
5. Procedures for regular assessments by school security professionals and law enforcement officers to evaluate the security needs of each school building and to provide recommendations for improvements if necessary.
6. Procedures to provide for regular communications between district officials, law enforcement officers, fire department officials, city and county officials, and local medical personnel to discuss crisis prevention and management strategies, including involvement by these parties in the development and revision of crisis prevention and management plans.
7. Procedures for the reporting of criminal activity to law enforcement.
