POLICY: Vanguard IKBA - Fourth through Sixth Grades Excess Missing Homework

POLICY ADOPTED: 2-13-18

1. Students in the fourth through sixth grades will be required to achieve an average of 85% for their homework grade, per class, per quarter.
2. Students achieving less than 85% for the overall homework grade in class will receive a strike if they are also missing five or more assignments in the quarter. A missing assignment is one that is turned in too late to receive credit, including assignments never turned in.
3. Students will be eligible to have a strike removed if they meet both the following criterion:
 - 85% or above homework average the following quarter in the subject for which the strike was earned
 - Fewer than five missing assignments the following quarter in the subject for which the strike was earned
4. If a student has four strikes at the end of the year, that student loses his priority status for admission to The Vanguard School the following year.
5. If under extraordinary circumstances, the student is unable to meet these criteria, the Principal may use his discretion to remove a strike.
6. The terms of this policy will not apply to students whose non-completion of homework results from inability to handle academic material or to homework assignments that violate the Homework Policy.

Procedures:

Parents of students accumulating strikes or eliminating strikes will receive written communication of their student's status at the end of each quarter.
