

The Vanguard School Junior High Supply List School Year 2025-2026

Before New Student Orientation (for new students and incoming 7th grade students) or the first day of school (for all other students), ensure that all core subject binders are assembled and labeled with your child's name and the class title.

Community

These supplies are delivered to classrooms during back-to-school events.

- 4 boxes of tissues
- 1 container sanitizer wipes
- 1 package college-ruled loose-leaf paper (100 sheets per package)
- 7th Grade students:
 - Last name A-M: 1 roll of paper towels
 - Last name N-Z: 1 12 to 24 oz bottle hand sanitizer
- 8th Grade students:
 - Last name A-M: 1 box gallon Ziplock bags
 - Last name N-Z: 1 box quart Ziplock bags

Individual

These supplies are stored in student lockers and backpacks.

- Student Fee \$125, according to CRS 22-32-117, paid during back-to-school events
- Verify access to school-provided Microsoft 365 Account
 - *This will be supported by the school during the first month of school.*
- Water bottle
- 1 flash drive/USB
- 1 package blue/black pens (24 count or more)
- 1 package red pens (24 count or more)
- 1 package pencils (and replacement lead if mechanical) (24 count or more)
- 4 packages of college-ruled loose-leaf paper (100 sheets per package)
 - *This may need to be replenished throughout the year.*
- 3 packages of 3x5 notecards (100 count per package)
- 1 package sticky notes (5 pads with 90 each, 450 count per package)
- 1 pack of highlighters (3 count or more colors)
- 1 pack of colored pencils (12 or more colors)
- 1 pair scissors
- 1 pack whiteboard markers (5 count or more)
- 1 two-pocket folder (for organizing homework)

These supplies are stored in student lockers and backpacks.

- 1" binder

English

- 1.5" binder
- Five-tab dividers

Math

- 2.5 inch binder
- Five-tab dividers
- 2 100-page spiral notebook (one per semester for notes)
- Twelve-inch ruler with centimeters
- Graph paper
 - *May be used instead of lined paper for homework assignments*

Specific materials per class:

- *Course 2 and 2+*: Metal compass and clear plastic protractor
- *Course 3*: None
- *Course 3+ and Algebra I*: TI-84 or TI-84 plus graphing calculator by the start of the second quarter
- *Geometry*: TI-83 Plus or TI-84 graphing calculator, metal compass, protractor, 3x5 notecards in 3-4 different colors (totaling to 300), binder rings (to hold notecards)

Science

- 1” binder
- Six-tab dividers
- 3 sheet protectors
- Composition book, non-spiral, sewn binding
- Calculator (minimum four-function)

History

- 1” binder
- Five-tab dividers
- 2 100-page composition notebooks (one per semester)

Electives

These supplies are stored in student lockers and backpacks.

- Athletic running shoes
 - *casual shoes like canvas/toe shoes are not allowed*
- Workout clothes:
 - *Shorts (fingertip or longer), pants, long sleeve and short sleeve t-shirts, jacket, gloves, hat*
- Combination lock

- Two-pocket folder
- Instrument

- ½ in. binder

Creative Writing

- One-subject notebook with a pocket
 - *If this combination cannot be found, having both a notebook and a two-pocket folder can be used instead.*

Life Skills

- Two-pocket folder with fasteners

- ½ in. binder
- Five-tab dividers

Rocketry

- ½ in. binder
- Five-tab dividers
- \$50 activity fee for rocket kit
 - *paid during the school year*

Yearbook

- ½ in. binder
- Five-tab dividers
- Camera and SD card (optional)

- Supplies already accounted for in the individual section. No additional supplies needed.
